# Mountain Activities



## Jais Flight

The world's longest zipline at 2,8km soars across the jagged peaks of the Hajar Mountains at speeds of up to 160kph.



## Jais Sky Tour

This thrilling two-hour tour involves 6 ziplines that range from just 337 metres to more than 1km.



## Jais Sledder

Fun for all the family, this exhilarating toboggan ride hurtles around the mountains at speeds of up to 40kph.



## Afternoon Tea at 1484 by Puro

With temperatures up to 10 degrees cooler than on sea level, the UAE's highest Afternoon tea can be enjoyed on the outdoor terrace all-year-round.



## Camp 1770

The highest camp in the UAE is open to groups during the summer. A peaceful mountain retreat, it's the place to explore the great outdoors and enjoy Emirati cuisine by the fire.



## Jais Viewing Deck Park

This beauty spot on Jebel Jais is situated 1,250 metres above sea level. It's the place to take in stunning views of the mountains and the coast beyond.





# Be Active Outdoors



## **Swimming with Camels**

Visitors can enjoy a once-in-a-lifetime swim with a Ras Al Khaimah camel, cooling down at the same time.



## **Night Golf at the Al Hamra Golf Club**

Using the latest zero-pollution floodlights to illuminate the composite nine-hole course, golfers of all abilities can play under the stars.



## **Water Sports at Hotels**

The options are endless, from high-speed jet skis, banana boats, fly boarding and parasailing, to more sedate options like kayaking.



## **Bicycle Ride on the Al Marjan Island**

Hire a bike or an e-scooter and zip around the running track on Al Marjan Island, taking in views of the Arabian Gulf.



## **Sunrise/Sunset Desert Horse Ride**

When the sun sets or rises, jump on a horse for a breathtaking ride at the Al Wadi Equestrian Centre.



## **Desert Safari**

A late afternoon adventure not to be missed, exploring the peaks and troughs of Ras Al Khaimah's desert dunes in a four-wheel drive.



## **Evening Run on the Al Marjan Island Running Track**

In the summer, runners and walkers can hit this scenic track at night when the sun sets and temperatures cool.

## **Padel Tennis at the Padel Beach Al Hamra**

Keep fit and cool at the first indoor padel tennis court in Ras Al Khaimah. A mix between tennis and squash, but easier, and played on a smaller court – padel tennis is a fun family activity that's best played in doubles.



## **Tridom at Manar Mall**

Ideal for children and big kids at heart, Tridom is an indoor entertainment centre with rides to keep you occupied for hours.



## **Fly Zone Trampoline Park**

A very bouncy indoor adventure playground, you can play dodge ball, try the Ninja Warrior obstacle course, freestyle it, jump in a foam pit or practice your moves on a super soft Air Bag.

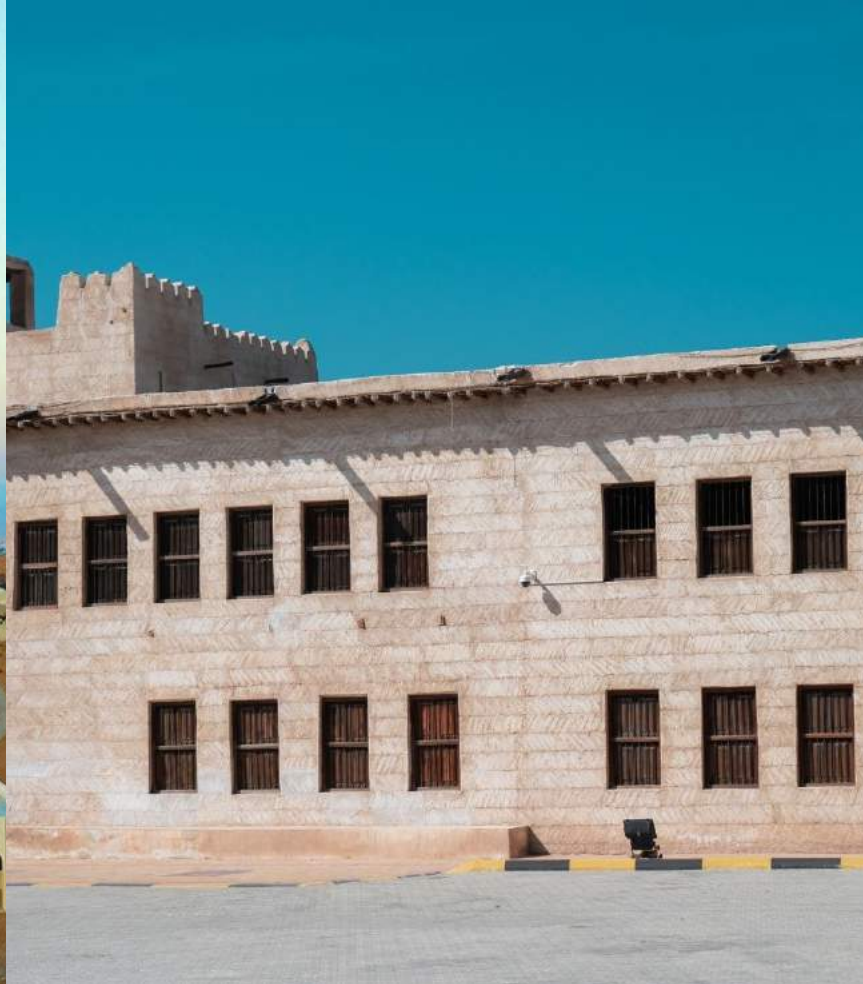






### Al Qassimi Palace

It's not only famous for its messy seafood and American BBQ, but its games, from billiards and basketball to Jenga, and you can even ride the bucking rodeo bull!



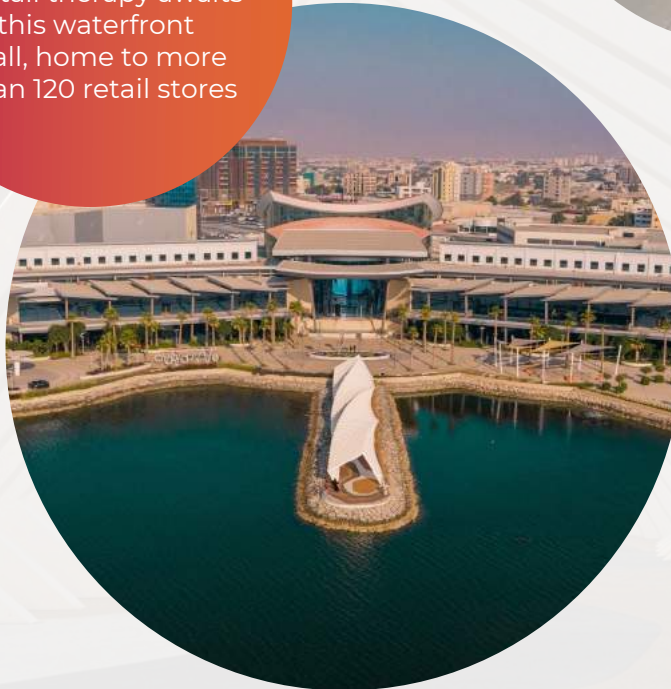
## Sun & Sand Sports Factory Outlet
